

ABOUT THE COLLEGE OF NURSING

As New Jersey's first college to offer a Bachelor of Science in Nursing (B.S.N.) program, Seton Hall's College of Nursing has educated approximately one-third of all New Jersey nurses and is one of the few universities in the country to be an approved College of Nursing for Army ROTC nursing candidates. *U.S. News & World Report* ranks Seton Hall University College of Nursing as one of the top graduate nursing programs in the country. Offering educational opportunities from B.S.N. degree through the Doctor of Nursing Practice (D.N.P.) and Ph.D., the College's mission is to educate baccalaureate-prepared generalists and advanced practitioners of nursing who aspire to be innovators and leaders in the nursing profession with a commitment to lifelong learning, service and leadership for the greater good of the global society.

DOCTORAL PROGRAMS

Doctor of Philosophy in Nursing (Ph.D.)

Designed to prepare nurse scholars for a lifetime of advanced research, our flagship Ph.D. program is helping shape the next generation of intellectual leadership in nursing.

Doctor of Nursing Practice (D.N.P.) — online

The College of Nursing offers a 31+ credit online Doctor of Nursing Practice (D.N.P.) degree program for the student who has completed an M.S.N. with Direct Care (Advanced Practice) and Indirect Care (Administration and Leadership) options. Students can also enter at the post-baccalaureate level, depending on their major.

MASTER OF SCIENCE PROGRAMS

M.S.N. Adult-Gerontology Acute Care or Primary Care Nurse Practitioner AND M.S.N. Pediatric Primary Care Nurse Practitioner – all online

Seton Hall is recognized by *U.S. News & World Report* as having one of the top programs in the nation for Online Graduate Nursing Programs, ranking 17th in the nation, making it the top online graduate nursing program in New Jersey in 2020. The College of Nursing offers online nurse practitioner programs in adult-gerontology nurse practitioner (primary and acute care) and pediatric nurse practitioner (primary care).

NEW M.S.N., Psychiatric-Mental Health Nurse Practitioner – online

The College of Nursing now offers an Online M.S.N. in Psychiatric/Mental Health Nurse Practitioner program, which is designed to prepare nurses to assess, diagnose and treat individuals and families for psychiatric disorders as their primary provider throughout their lifespan. Students graduate ready to pursue ANCC Psychiatric-Mental Health Nursing board certification.

R.N. to M.S.N. Degree Bridge – online

The R.N. to M.S.N. Degree Bridge provides registered nurses (R.N.s) who have an Associate in Science (A.S.) or Associate in Applied Science (A.A.S.) degree in nursing AND a non-nursing baccalaureate degree, with an option to pursue a Master's degree in Nursing (M.S.N.).

Traditional Bachelor of Science in Nursing (B.S.N.)

Our signature four-year degree program lays the foundation for a successful career in nursing, combining in-depth theory, hands-on learning and intensive clinical practice exposure. Students split their time between Seton Hall's South Orange campus and its Interprofessional Health Sciences Campus in Nutley, New Jersey.

Accelerated Second Degree B.S.N.

This 14-month program is for students who hold a non-nursing bachelor's degree. Locations include Georgian Court University Campus in Lakewood, New Jersey, (September start) and Seton Hall's Interprofessional Health Sciences Campus in Nutley, New Jersey (January start).
